- If your child has a medical emergency (not regular or routine illness) and cannot participate in class please contact staff as soon as possible.



PERMIT HOLDER REQUIREMENTS

- Must provide proof of insurance.
- Must provide own advertisement for program.
- Registration handled by the permit holder.


