

Requirements for Independent Contractors

- 1. All contractors, sub-contractors and volunteers must be fingerprinted through the City of San Diego Live Scan Process
- 2. Contractor must submit a business license and proof of insurance
- 3. City staff handles all registration for the program
- 4. Contractor must provide Worker's Comp. coverage for all employees

Permit Holder Requirements*

- 1.Must provide proof of insurance
- 2. Must provide own advertisement for program
- Registration is not required to submit proof of fingerprinting for their coaches, volunteers and/or instructors.
- All Permit Holders are identified with an **asterisk on this program.
